— [Congratulations to Manuela Veloso](#), the Herbert A. Simon University Professor, Emeritus, former head of the Machine Learning Department and head of [J.P. Morgan AI Research](#), who was named recently to the list of most influential women in engineering by Academic Influence. The [list of women](#) includes astronauts, founders and CEOs of well-known technology and Fortune 500 companies, a Nobel laureate, and researchers from around the world. [Forbes reported](#) that Manula ranked among the top 10 of the 35 women on this new list.

— Lee Weiss, professor emeritus and a founding member of the Robotics Institute, died two weeks ago at the age of 70. For those of you, like me, who had the privilege of working with Lee, you know he was a brilliant scientist while also serving as a wonderful mentor to many of us.
